What is Visual Discrimination?

Visual discrimination is the ability to recognise and classify differences in objects, symbols, or shapes. These distinctions can be classified according to colour, position, form, pattern, texture, and size. The eyes take in information from their surroundings, and numerous cells detect and transfer signals to the brain. Visual discrimination can be used to identify and classify items, symbols, shapes, and so on based on distinctions in colour, shape, size, texture, or orientation.

In this activity, kids will apply their letter visual discrimination skills.


This worksheet contains two (2) sets of clip cards: the **Capital** and **small** letters.



DIRECTION:


- You will distribute the cards and clip to the children.






