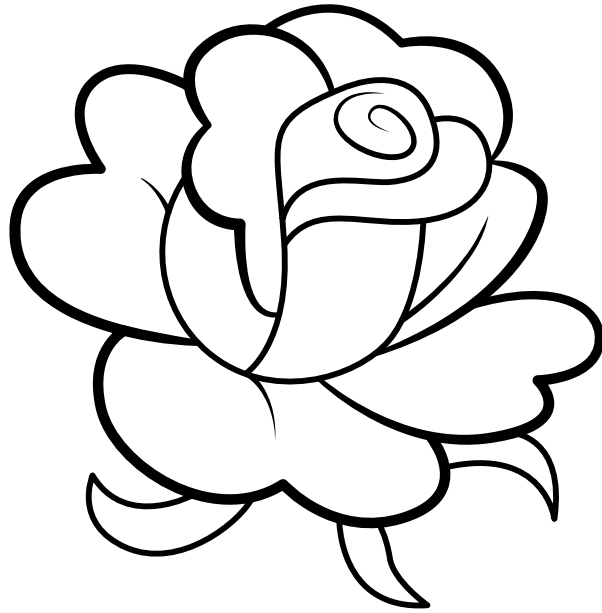


The rose seed becomes
a sprout.

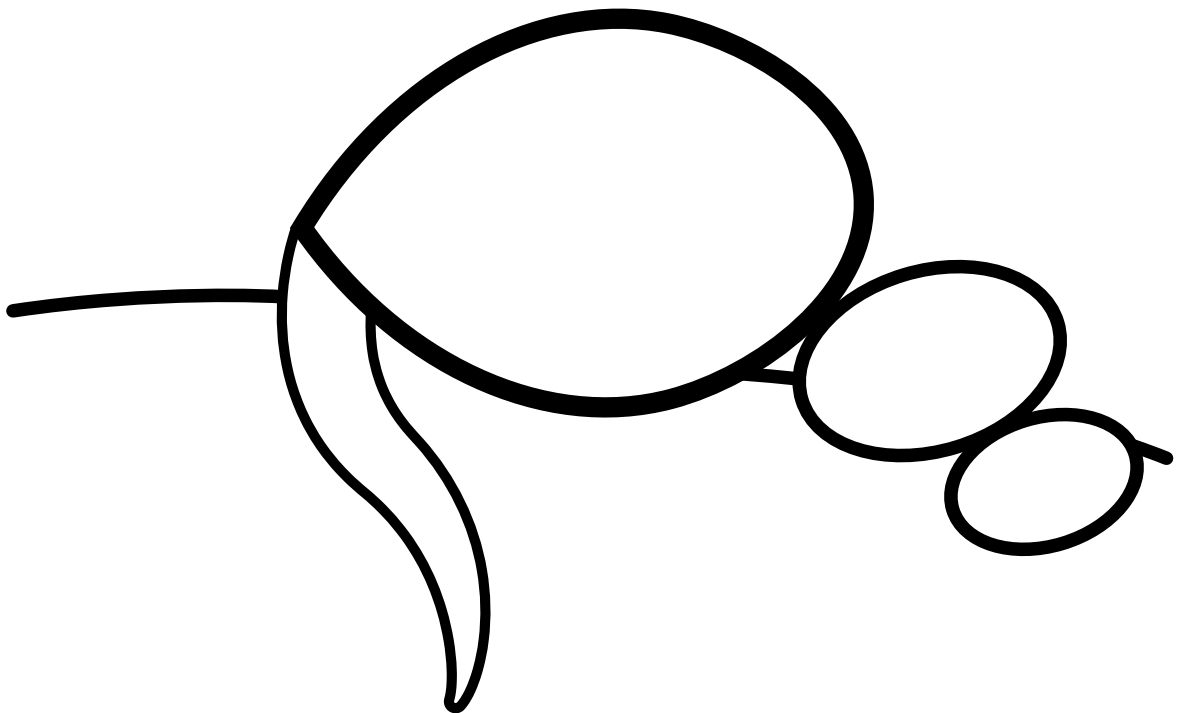


The sprouts develop
into young plants.

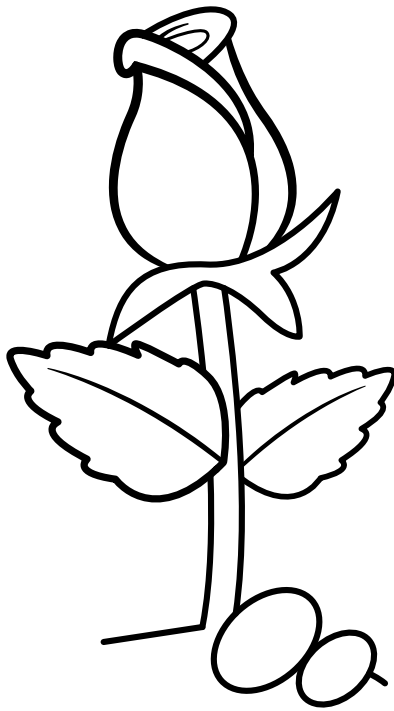

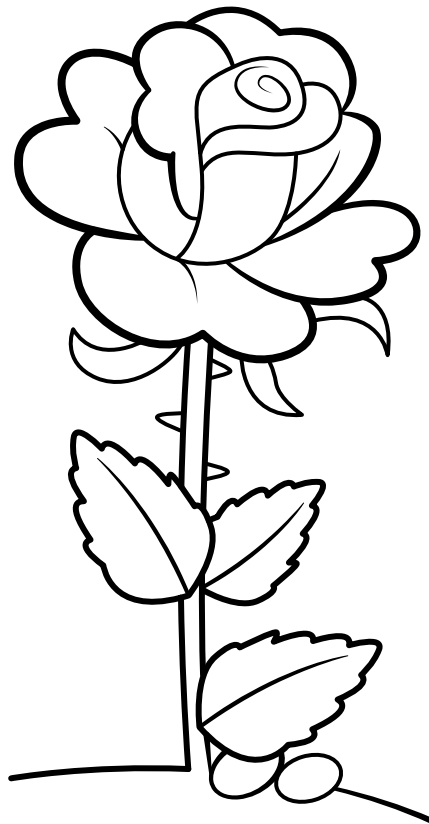

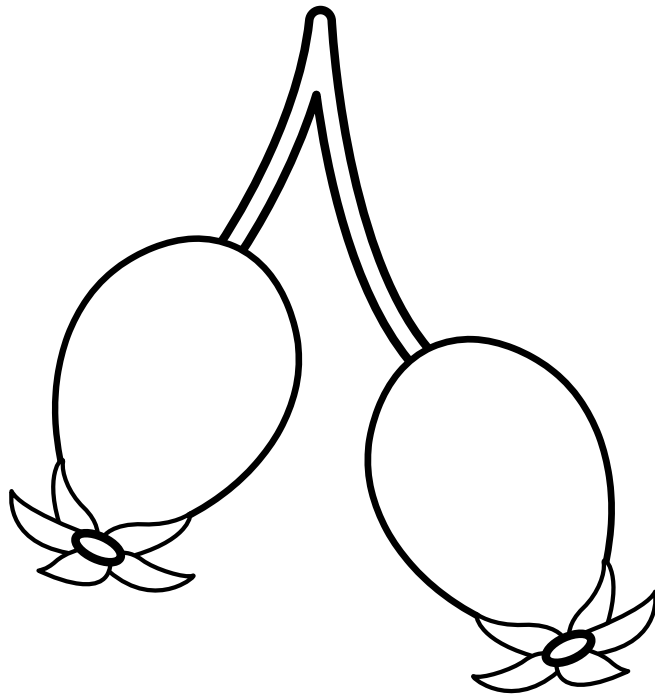
