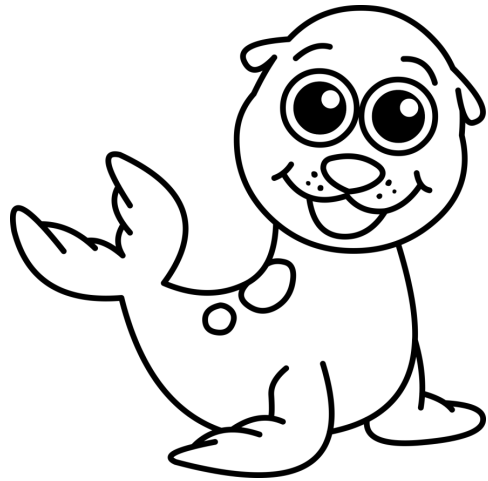
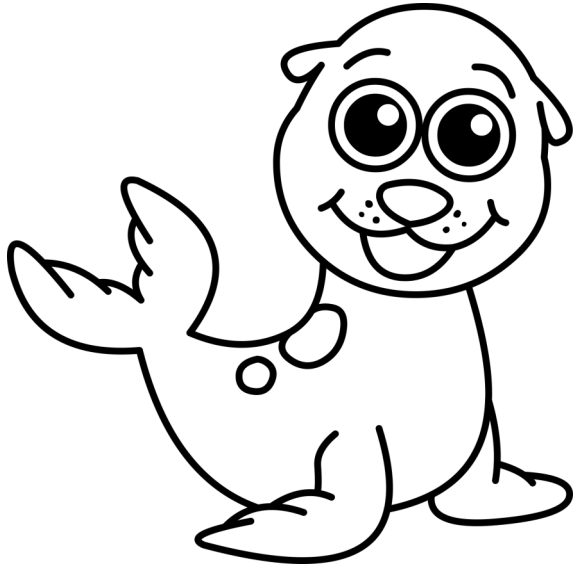
A clown fish  
swims in the ocean.



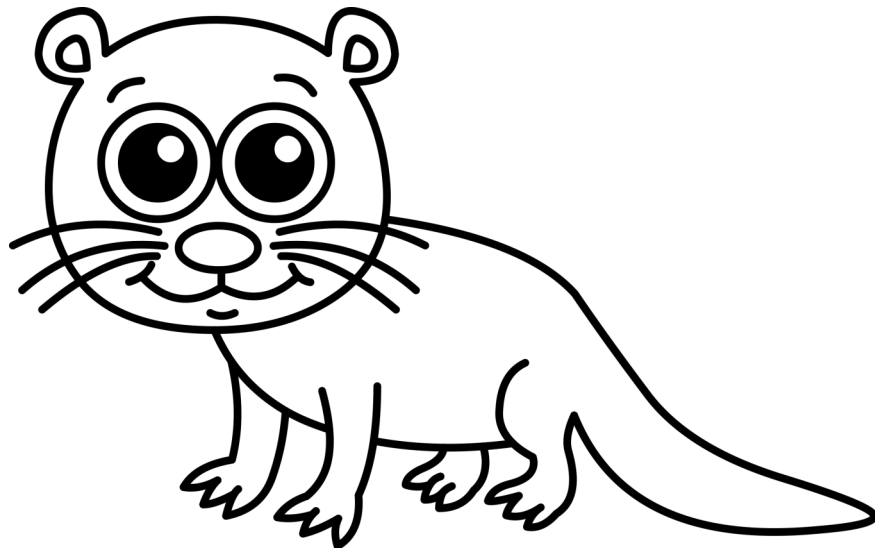
A dolphin  
swims in the ocean.



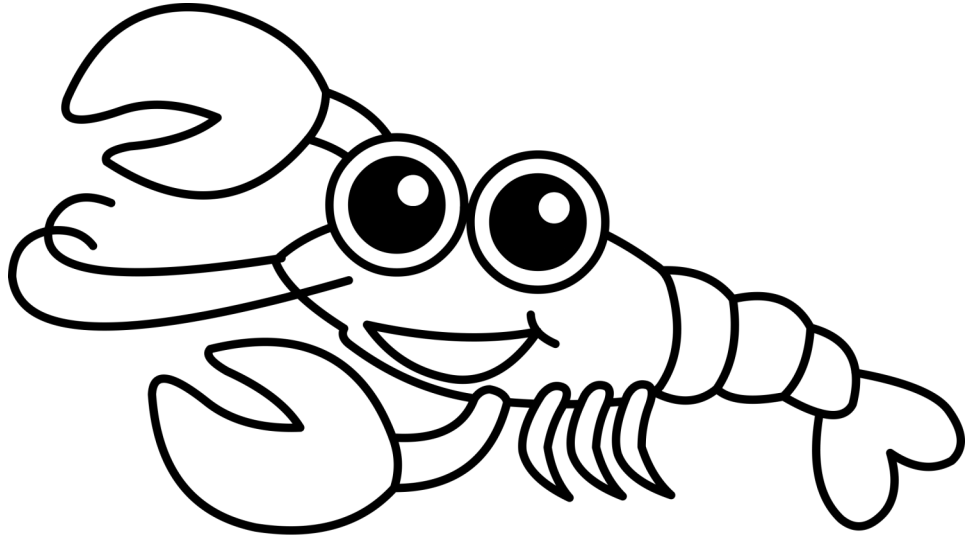
Seals swim  
in the ocean.



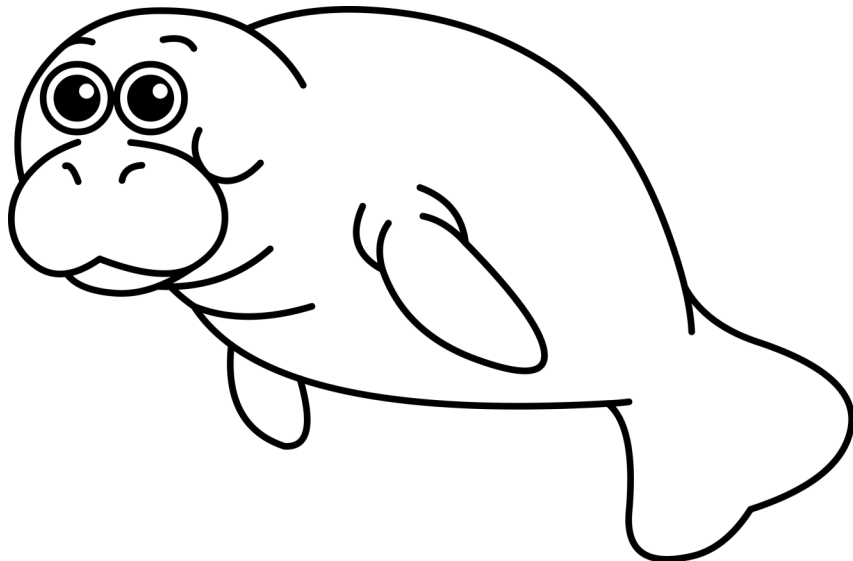
An otter swims
